

2026 Fairhaven Homecoming Day Fair

Vendor Rules - Reminders - Entry Map & Directions

CHECK-IN REQUIRED

All vendors must enter through the official check-in point at Union Street and Walnut Street before setting up. See enclosed directions and map.

Please review your booth assignment carefully and save the booth assignment email or take a screenshot of the information. You will need to have your booth number and location readily available when you arrive at check-in. Check-in moves much faster when vendors arrive prepared.

- Do not enter the Fairgrounds from any other location.
- Vendor parking passes will be distributed at check-in.
- Volunteers will direct you to your assigned booth.

SET-UP HOURS

- Vendors may not enter the Fairgrounds before 6:30 a.m.
- Pull as close to the curb as possible when unloading.
- Unload promptly and move your vehicle out of the Fairgrounds before setting up your booth.
- Volunteer assistance is available if needed.

IMPORTANT: All vehicles must be removed from the Fairgrounds by 9:00 a.m. No exceptions.

DURING THE FAIR

The Fair runs from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

If you sell out before 4:00 p.m., please leave your booth in place until the Fair closes. You may cover your display if necessary.

BREAKDOWN & VEHICLE ENTRY

For safety reasons, vehicles will not be permitted into the Fairgrounds until after 4:15 p.m.

- Enter only through the Walnut Street and Union Street entrance.
- Follow the directions provided by volunteers and police officers.
- Breakdown instructions will be distributed on the day of the Fair.

CLEAN-UP REQUIREMENTS

Vendors are responsible for leaving their space clean.

Please remove all trash, boxes, packing materials, and display items. Failure to comply with Fair rules may result in denial of future participation.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following are not permitted within the Fairgrounds:

- Alcoholic beverages
- Petitions
- Balloons displaying logos

Brochures and promotional materials may only be distributed from within your booth.

DIRECTIONS

From Points East: Take I-195 West: Take Exit 29 (formerly Exit 18) for MA-240 South. Turn right at the second traffic light onto Huttleston Avenue (Route 6). After passing through the traffic light at Alden Road, take the next left onto Washington Street. Follow Washington Street to the second stop sign and turn left onto Green Street. Continue to the vendor entrance as shown on the map.

From Points North and West: Take I-195 East toward Cape Cod. Take Exit 26 (formerly Exit 15) for Route 18 South. Follow signs for Route 6 East/Fairhaven and cross the bridge. Turn right at the third traffic light onto Green Street. Continue through the stop sign at Washington Street and follow the map to the vendor entrance.

All vendors must enter the Fairgrounds by driving south on Green Street to Union Street and proceeding west to the check-in point located at Union Street and Walnut Street.
